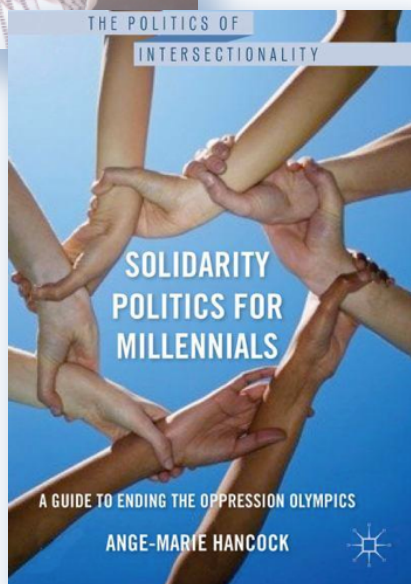


BEYOND THE OPPRESSION OLYMPICS
